12.3. Proportion of recycled waste

12.3.1. Waste tracking

The minimal wastage food in the common mess and other outlets is achieved through socially responsible education activity for students and staff of the university. The quantity of wastage of food is tracked on daily basis in the common mess and other eatery outlets on the campus through proper records and communicated to stakeholders and also display educative notes in the common mess.

The food wastage is segregated to dry and solid waste for further value addition as feed for animals and feed for STP tank. The shavings of the vegetables and other plant based wastes are utilized in composting process along with various biomass and leaf litter available on the campus premises.

Description:

The average waste generations as per the University records are as follows:

2. Vegetable peels - 70 kgs/ day
3. Food waste - 100 kgs/ day
4. Inorganic waste – 60 kgs/ day
5. Sewage water - 250000 litres/ day
