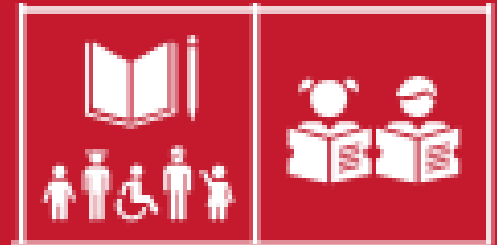
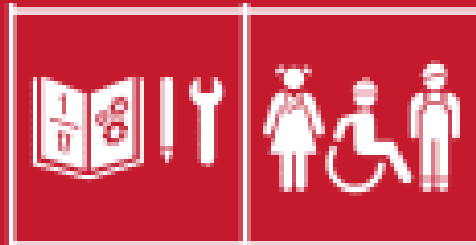
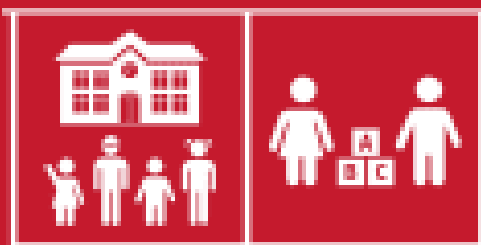


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About Us

INTRODUCTION

India is a vast country with over 1.3 billion people with close to 200 million children studying in primary and secondary schools. The majority of these children are in rural areas, spread across 649,481 villages in the country. India has many accomplishments to celebrate in education.

According to the Baseline Report of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) India Index released by NITI Aayog, the performance of the country with respect to attainment of targets under SDG 4, Quality Education is scored 57 out of 100.

However, the state of Odisha having third largest number of villages in India face plenty of challenges to meet the targets under SDG 4 of imparting quality education for all. It scored 45 in the index of attainment of SDG 4 in 2020 as compared to 40 in 2019. The improvement in the score is attributed to many factors and Higher Education Institutions like Sri Sri University is one of them.

Being from the parentage of one of the largest voluntary based global NGOs 'The Art of Living Foundation', Sri Sri University is committed towards ensuring inclusive and equitable quality education and promoting lifelong learning opportunities for all. empowering rural youths for earning livelihood

VIDYA SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE

VIDYA (Construction Skill Training Centre) imparts 90 days free, residential, vocational and skill development training in construction skills viz., (i) Masonry and (ii) Bar Bending and Steel Fixing trade to underprivileged, Below Poverty Line (BPL) and orphaned youths aged between 18 and 35 years from various backward districts of the Odisha. Besides vocational training, they are imparted the Art of Living Course of Yoga, meditation, Pranayam and 'SudarshanKriya' as a part of Youth Leadership Training Programme. This helps students for character building; mental development and good health along with domain expertise on the construction trade.

Aim of this vocational training centre is to qualify students in technical trade, mould them as responsible citizens with good character and to bring them in the main stream of society.

This initiative is meant to accelerate sustainable rural development and growth of peace initiatives in the society through education. This also aims to orient youth in original thinking for delving deep, pondering further and looking beyond obvious for broadening spheres of learning, responsibilities and work towards national reconstruction and socio economic betterment and development of our society. Vidya has trained and placed 1000+ youths in 2021.

Sri Sri Koushal Vikas Kendra (SSKVK)

Sri Sri University runs Sri Sri Koushal Vikas Kendra, a solar and electrician skill training centre in collaboration with Schneider Solar. 500+ unemployed youths have been trained in Solar electrification as their vocational skills for 90 days and suitably placed during 2021.

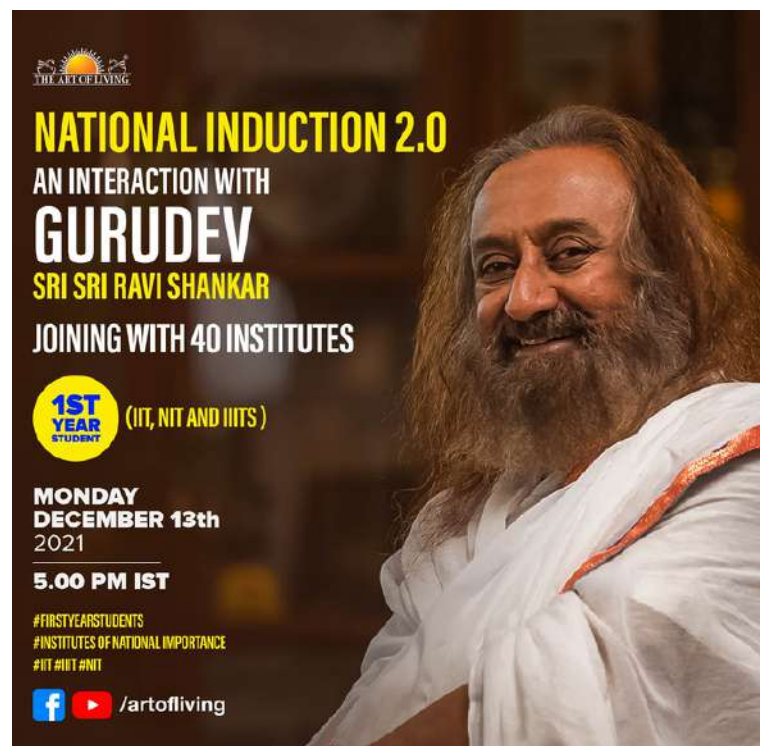
National Induction 2.0 addressing premier educational institutes

Our lifetime President, Gurudev Sri Sri Ravi Shankar 's earliest education based initiatives focused on children of marginalized communities who would otherwise be child laborers. In October 2007, the Art of Living Foundation unveiled a joint declaration with UNICEF to further the cause of child rights. The Foundation works to provide both quality education as well as health care to students and parents. Students and parents regularly attend stress-relief workshops and are provided free stationery, uniforms, and mid-day meals.

He has inspired in building 982+ free schools to provide free, holistic, value-based education to under-privileged children in rural, tribal and socio-economically backward places in India.

They are provided textbooks, uniforms, and in some cases transportation free of cost. The practice of yoga and meditation is integrated into the curriculum of the school and co-curricular activities ensure the holistic development of the child.

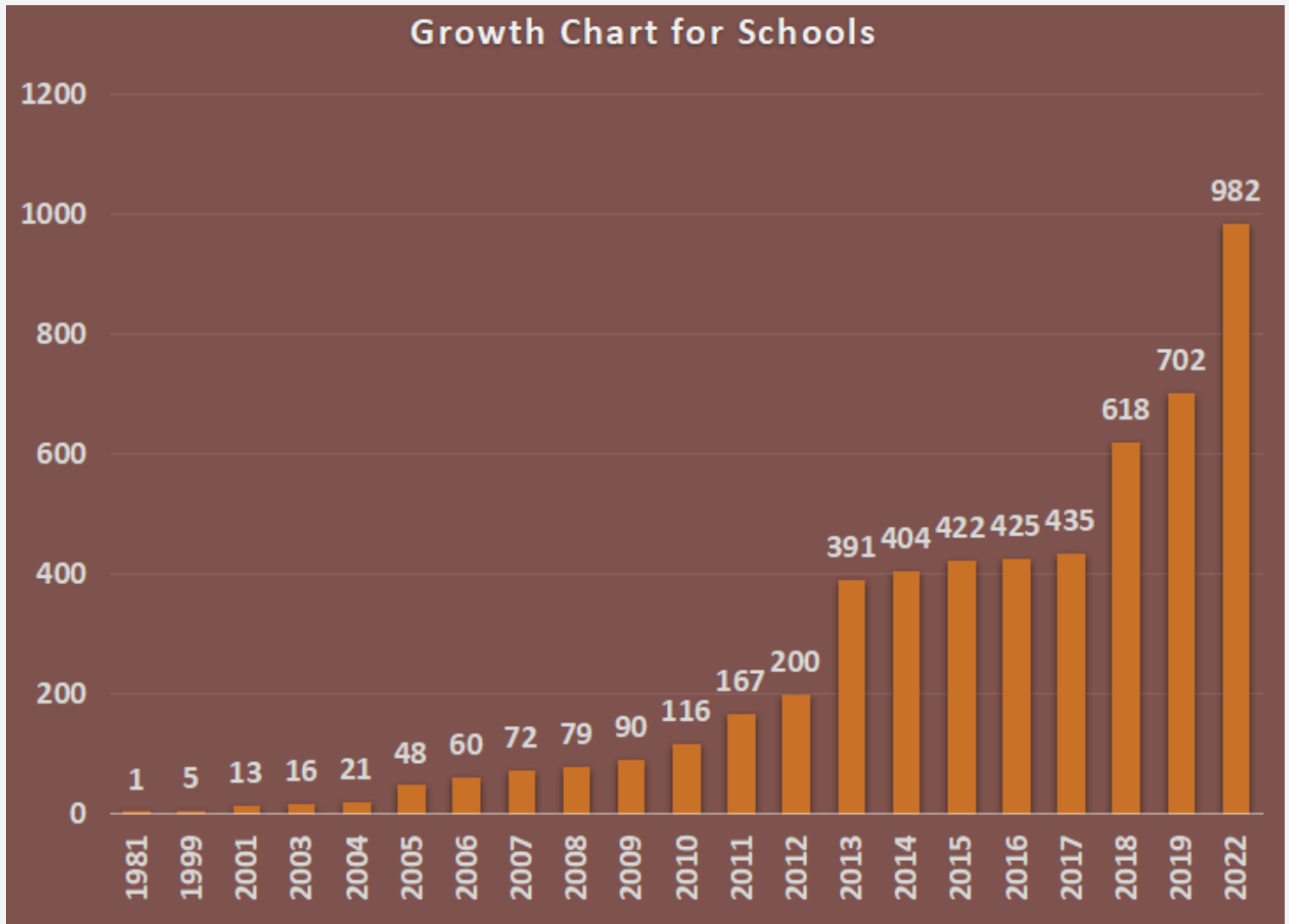
