11.2.1 Public access to buildings

Sri Sri University supports numerous activities for its promotion by encouraging public participation. Our University is committed to creating an environmentally friendly and ecological campus and a high-quality learning environment for outdoor teaching. It is not only rich in architectural features, but also it has cultural and historical significance.

During the excavation work for the construction of the University, the first idol which appeared on the site was of Lord Ganesha. This more than 500 year old antique idol of Lord Ganesha is now a temple in the campus which is accessed by the local public during the college hours i.e. from 9:30 am to 5:30 pm from Gate no 01, the main entry to the University. The Pooja (prayer) is performed here on a daily basis.

Sri Sri University respects and encourages the intangible heritage of India by performing Rudra Pooja which is an ancient practice followed since time immemorial. Shruti building, the main Academic block in Sri Sri University is accessible to the local public and visitors on every Monday morning and Thursday evening to attend this Rudra Pooja.
