DESIGN HACKATHON (PILOT) PROJECT

Taru Leading Edge, the industrial partner and the Faculty of Architecture at Sri Sri University collaborated to find innovative habitat solutions for the humanitarian crisis resulting from disasters and paved the way for budding architects to build back better. In this context, a Design Hackathon for a period of three weeks was launched with fourth-year students (2017- 22 batch) with a focus on the following problem statement – The objective was to design sustainable buildings and settlements, which are resilient and can cope with natural and anthropogenic disasters. The challenge was to propose/develop ready-to-build designs for socially inclusive, cost-effective housing that are a part of livable neighbourhood directly contributing to sustainable cities and communities (SDG 11).

The site ‘Bhoinagar slum’ is located in the heart of the Bhubaneswar city — well surrounded by



existing infrastructure. The site is well connected with major landmarks like Kalinga Stadium, Raj Bhavan, NICCO Park and several high-profile commercial establishments.


