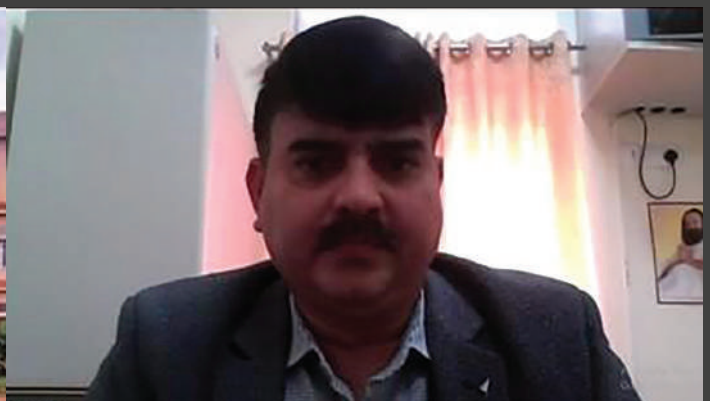

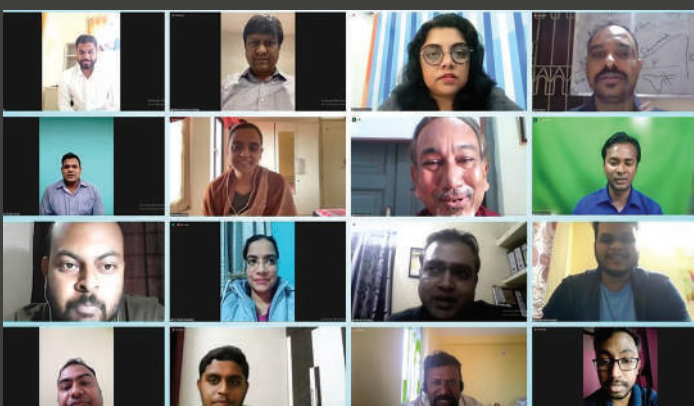


## Interaction with Founders of Start-ups Incubated under The SSU Incubation Centre

## Launch Ceremony of SSU VISION 2030

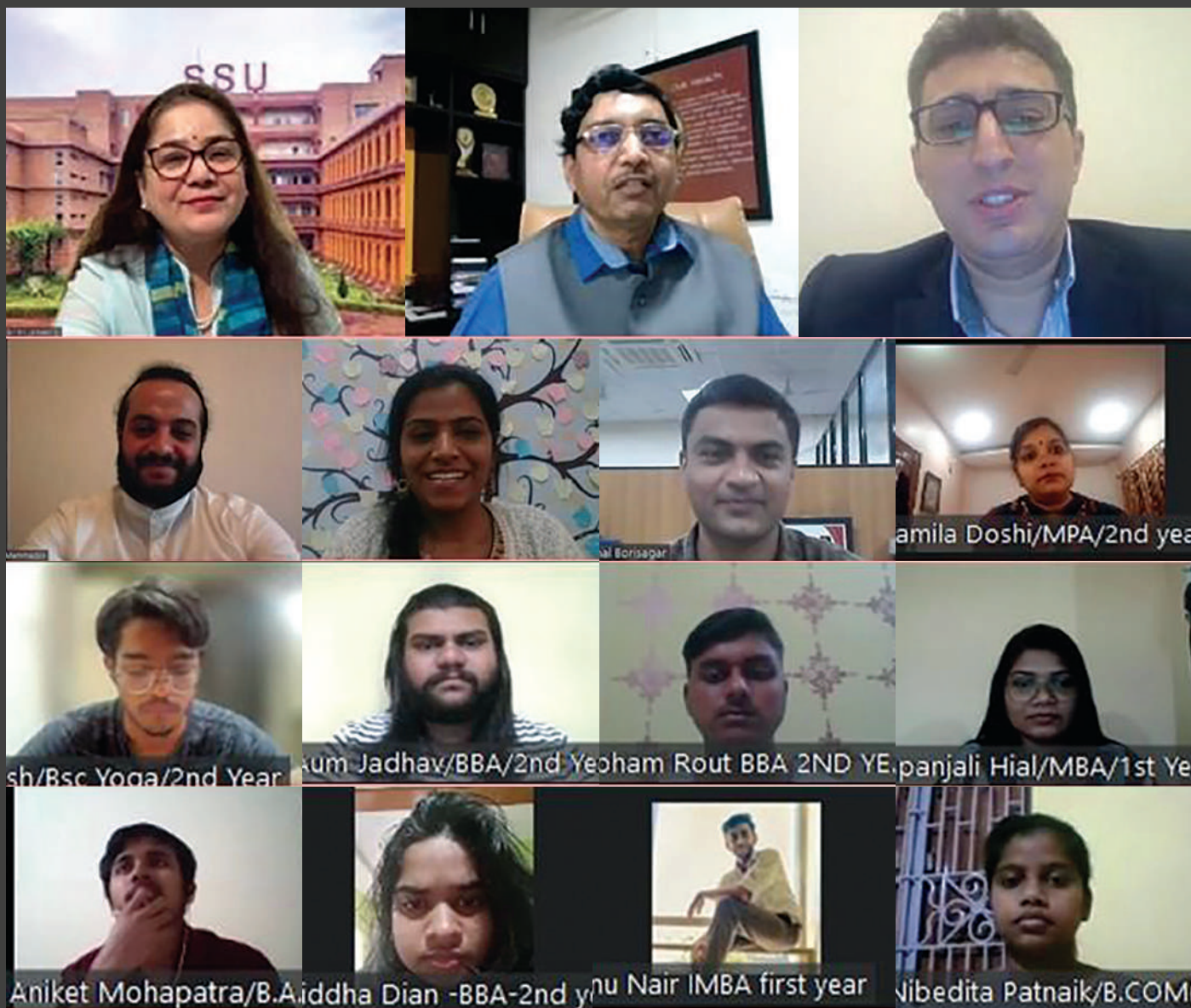

- Some students who successfully completed the program will be selected to TRAVEL to Azerbaijan for summer and winter school fully sponsored by the Govt. of Azerbaijan.

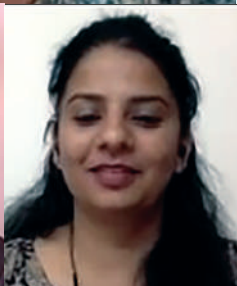
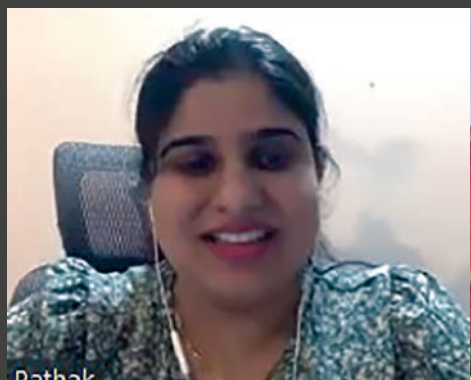
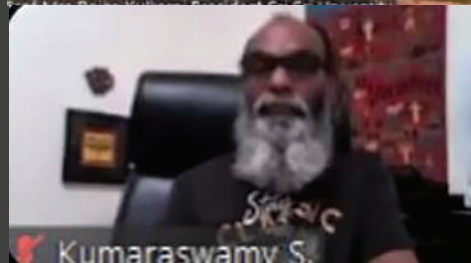


# Global Leadership Series

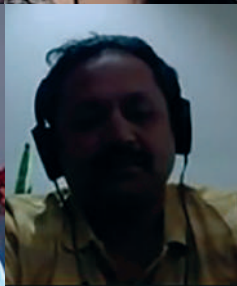

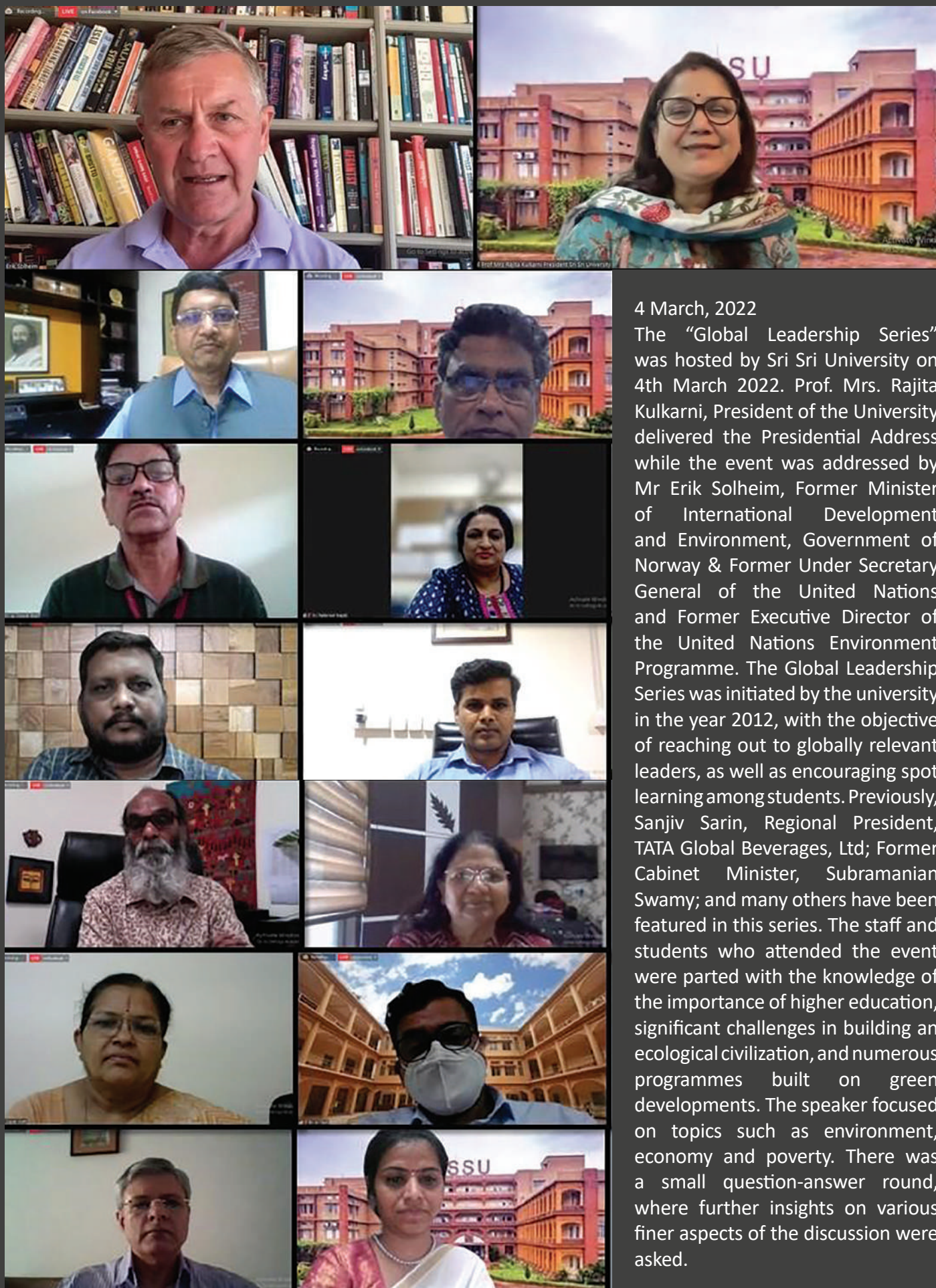
27 February, 2022

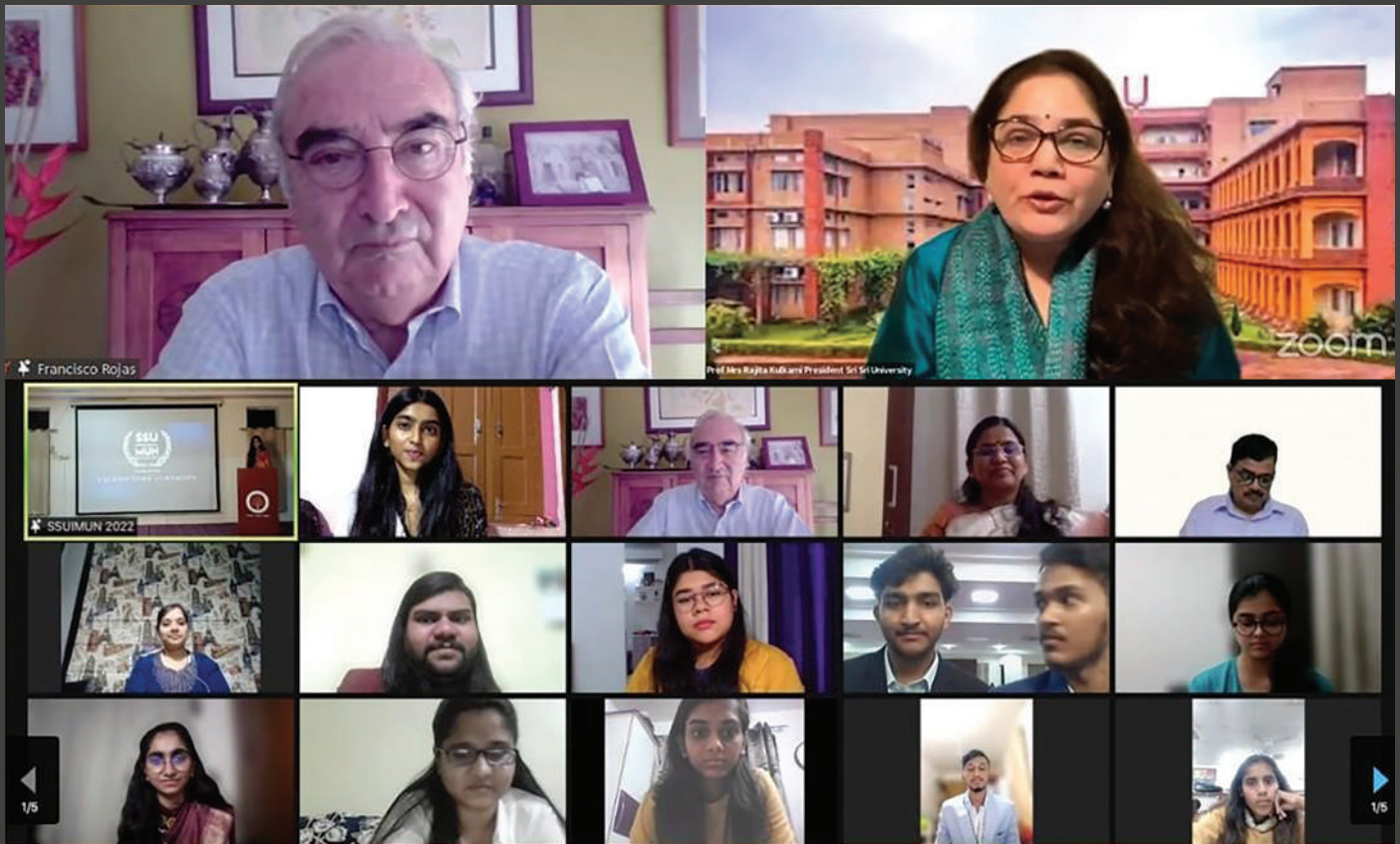


4 March, 2022

# Valedictory Ceremony of SSU IMUN 5.0

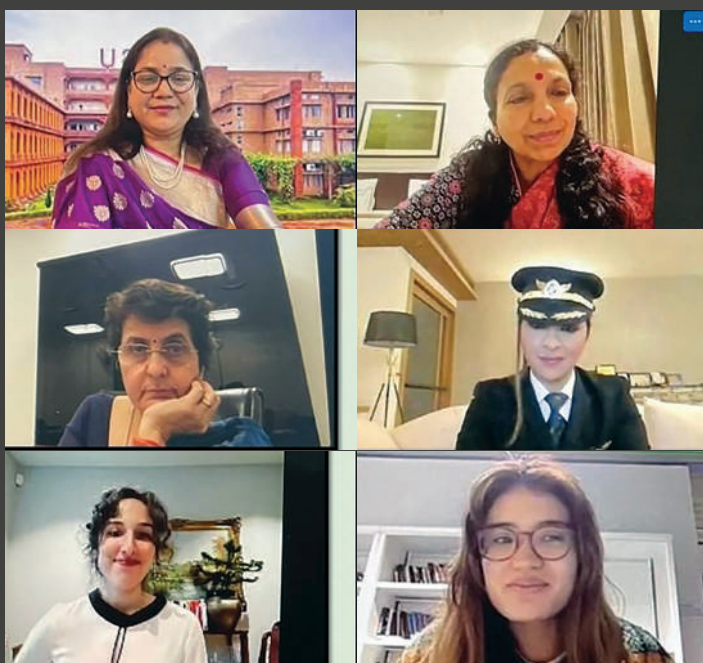


20 February, 2022

## 23<sup>rd</sup> World Education Summit 2022



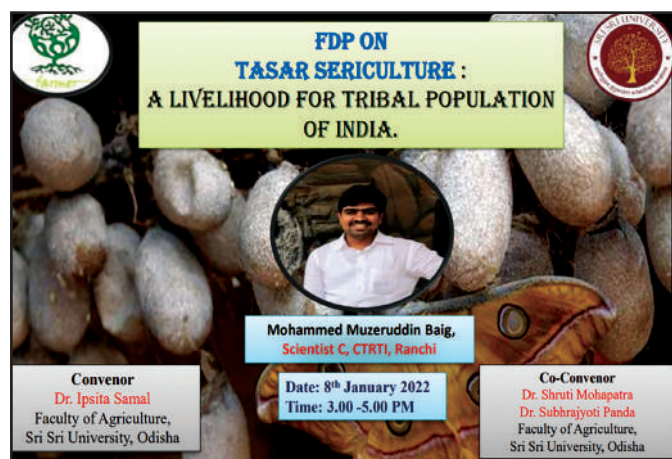

## Virtual Workshop for Floripreneurs in India





3. It promotes early treatment.

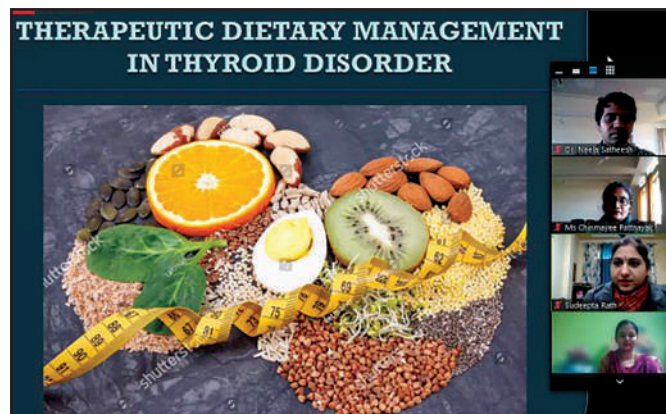


