## **Guidelines for the Competition**

- 1. The competition will start at 09.30 am sharp. All participants are requested to be at the venue at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the competition. Only one attendee/ assistant is permitted with each participant. Please note that we will not permit more than one person along with the competitor, into the auditorium.
- **2.** The participants are required to be in complete Odissi costume for the competition. We will not permit any form of innovation with the costume.
- **3.** All the music has to be provided to the organisers in a pen drive. Connecting of mobile phones for music will not be permitted. The music has to be on mp3/wav format.
- **4.** The participants are meant to bring in their own food and drinks. The organisers will not provide any food or drink to the participants. Please note that dining is strictly prohibited in the auditorium. Kindly refrain from loitering around the premises of the auditorium.
- **5.** The decisions of the judges will be final and abiding and no negotiations will be entertained.
- **6.** The participants are meant to stay till the end of the competition and the results will be declared on the same day, in the evening of 1.6.2023. The prizes and participation certificates will be distributed during a programme that is being organised on 2.06.2023 at 7 pm.
- 7. Each participant will receive their certificate of participation on 2.06.23 at 7pm, after the performances.
- **8.** Each participant will be given a time slot of 10 minutes and they have to perform one Pallavi or one Abhinaya or a combination of both within the stipulated time. Participants are requested to stick to the time provided and we will not permit extra time, exceeding which the audio will be stopped. However, this is subject to the discretion of the judges who might shorten the time duration of a participant. No innovations are permissible with the selected item and only traditional Odissi dance and music is permitted.
- **9.** The first three winners of the competition will give a recital on 2.06.23 at 7pm.
