#### **Description:**

There is regular survey of flora and fauna of Sri Sri University campus. Each species is subjected to the IUCN redlist to know the conservation status. University has a policy to conserve and to restore the threatened species included in the IUCN redlist. University is committed to follow the IUCN guidelines (**Guidelines attached**). The rich forest cover in the campus provides shelter to many faunal species. A total of 8 species of mammals, 93 species of birds, 47 species of butterflies and 10 species of herpetofauna have been assessed for their conservation status. The updated list of animal species along with their IUCN conservation status is given below:
