Description:

1. On the occasion of 21st March, 2023 (World Forest Day), Rovers and Rangers unit, along with the Faculty of Agriculture, collaborated to organize an event at Sandhapur village. During this event, the significance of agroforestry was elucidated to the villagers by the Faculty members of Sri Sri University.
