5.2.1 Proportion of women first-generation - 1: 3.3

Number of women starting a degree - 272

Number of first-generation women starting a degree- 82

Description: SDG-5 Gender Equality recognizes the critical importance of ensuring equal opportunities and rights for all, regardless of gender. One specific target within this goal, 5.2, is to measure the Proportion of Graduates with Teaching Qualifications. This target, 5.2.1, specifically evaluates the proportion of women who are first-generation graduates pursuing teaching qualifications.

As of the latest available data, the proportion of women first-generation graduates with teaching qualifications stands at 1:3.3. This ratio underscores the progress made in promoting gender equality in education, demonstrating that women, particularly those who are first-generation college students, are increasingly pursuing teaching qualifications. Within this context, it's important to note that 272 women were starting a degree program related to teaching qualifications, of which 82 were first-generation students.

These numbers reflect the positive strides made in encouraging women, including those from underrepresented backgrounds, to enter the teaching profession. By supporting women in their educational journeys, providing equal opportunities, and eliminating barriers, we can continue to improve gender equality in education and contribute to a more inclusive and equitable society, in line with SDG-5's overall mission. This data serves as a reminder that progress is being made, but there is still work to be done to ensure true gender equality in education.
