6.4 Water Reuse

The treated wastewater is reused in the campus that reduces the dependency on other freshwater ecosystems. Several states in the country have implemented 'Safe Reuse of Treated Water' (SRTW) Policy and the state of Odisha is no exception to this. This policy envisages that by the end of 2022, all the states in the country would adopt and implement this policy and would contribute in achieving the targets of SDG 6 through setting up of sewage treatment plants (STP) in major towns and cities of each state.

6.4.1 Water Reuse Policy

The reuse of treated wastewater by Sri University aims at reducing the dependency on other freshwater resources and maximizing water reuse. Keeping in view the Safe Reuse of Treated Water (SRTW) Policy of various states of India, the Sri University has "Water Reuse Policy" since 2017. This policy is implemented in full and reviewed annually (**Plate 1**).

1. Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to conserve the water by following the preventive,

- reusing and recycling measures.
- Responsibility Centre: Office of Executive Registrar
 Procedure: The following procedures are to be adopted for the above:
 - a). The rainwater is to be stored in the natural and man-made ponds for the purpose of agriculture and horticulture.
 - b). The stored rainwater is to pass through water treatment plant inside the campus of SSU
 - c). Treated water is to be stored in the storage tanks.
 - d). Recycled water is to be assessed for the water quality to maintain the bureau of Indian standards (BIS).
 - e). Waste water from the kitchen and hostels is to be treated with output characteristics as per BIS.
 - f). Sewage water is to be treated and to be used for the agriculture and horticulture purposes.
 - g). Use of water efficient appliances to prevent the loss of water.
 - h). To aware and encourage the students and University staff for the conservation of water.
 - i). Regular monitoring of the production of the waste water is to be conducted. Whenever required new structures are to be constructed.
