Description:

To disseminate information on sustainable agriculture and food production to the local farmers and food producers, Sri Sri University hosts various events.

1. Student participation in community events like Rural Agricultural Work Experience (RAWE) program, KUS (Krushi Unnat Sahjogi), and Experience Learning Programs (ELP).

The student's participation in Experience Learning Programs and the RAWE program are among the crucial activities. Students and staff members actively participate in the visit to the fields of farmers and other stakeholders during this event, identifying issues and offering solutions.
