Description:

The raw materials needed for food preparation are obtained by Sri Sri University from local farmers, food processors, and university resources (farmlands). The faculty of Agriculture at Sri Sri University oversees 40 acres of agricultural land. A broader variety of crops, including fruits, vegetables, green leafy vegetables, and cereal crops, are cultivated by various faculty departments. The majority of the agricultural crops in this practise are produced using organic agricultural methods. Additionally, the Faculty of Agriculture's Apiculture and Mushroom Production Units contribute to the purchase of local food. A cow farm is operating profitably in this area keeping the desi breed cows (**Plate 1**) Organic farming practises are used to maintain this farm. In the main kitchen, milk from the university farm is used to prepare various dishes and beverages.

The additional ingredients needed for food preparation are always purchased from nearby food processors or farmers.
