

ZERO EMISSION POLICY

Objectives

- i). To develop a emission-free campus
- ii). To implement processes, procedures, and initiatives that ensure compliance with environmental legislation and best practice

Scope

1. The incineration of any form of waste, whether organic or synthetic, shall be strictly prohibited within the university campus.
2. The usage of coal shall be strictly forbidden on the campus premises.
3. Vehicles emitting smoke shall not be permitted to enter the campus.
4. A sustainable transportation alternative shall be implemented within the university campus to curtail the use of private vehicles.
5. The university shall actively promote the adoption of electric vehicles among students and staff. They shall be provided with amenities such as charging stations and a 50% discount on permanent parking fees.
6. The campus shall engage the university community through educational campaigns, workshops, and seminars to enhance awareness regarding the net zero emission policy. This initiative aims to foster changes in behaviour and encourage active participation.
7. The policy shall establish a framework for monitoring and reporting to trace the progress made toward achieving the net zero emission goal.
