**Purpose:** The main objectives of the tobacco and alcohol free Policy are to provide a health-enhancing clean environment to the residents, to improve the air quality in the premises and to reduce the hardships and sufferings faced by non-smokers in the campus.

**Responsibility Centre:** Office of Executive Registrar

**Procedure:** The following procedures are to be adopted for the above:

- a) The use of smoke and tobacco is to be banned within the boundary of University.
- b) The purchase and sale of smoking and tobacco are to be banned inside the University Campus.
- c) Vehicles emitting smoke in excess of the permissible limit are to be banned from entering the university campus.
- d) Vehicles are to be monitored for the pollution testing certificates.
- e) Burning of garbage is to be prohibited inside the University campus.
- f) The use of alcohol is to be banned inside the University campus.
- g) The use of any form of intoxicant is to be prohibited.
- h) Students, teachers, staff and all other stakeholders of University are to be aware and awakened about the health and social ills of drugs.
- i) Code of conduct is to be provided to students and staff regarding smoking, tobacco and alcohol.
- j) The breach of this policy by any of the students or staff is to be considered as a serious offense and to be prosecuted under disciplinary action.
